BLOSSOM BRAMBLE

£9.50

The Bramble cocktail was invented in the 1980s by a bartender at Edinburgh's Bramble Bar. Our version combines those original flavours with the cherry and lavender notes of the Japanese cherry blossom.

Ukiyo Blossom Gin, Lemon, Sugar, Blackberry

ESPRESSO MARTINI

£9.50

Originating in the early 80's in London, it was apparently created on the spot for a famous model who asked for a drink that would wake her up. Our twist on the classic will do just that!

Born Irish Whiskey, Espresso, Caramel, Vanilla

OLD FASHIONED

£9.50

The Old Fashioned's origins are debated, but it's often linked to the Pendennis Club in Louisville, Kentucky. The drink may have been invented by a bartender at the club and introduced to New York City by James E. Pepper, a bourbon distiller and member of the club.

PASSION FRUIT MARTINI

£9.50

A modern cocktail invented in 2002 by the owner of the LAB LONDON bar, it became an instant classic. Intensely fruity and tropical tasting notes are paired with a shot of Prosecco.

Absolute Vodka, Passion Fruit, Lime, Vanilla, Prose
